Refusal of English Language Services

To Parent/Guardian,

The State of Utah requires that our school district assess the English language proficiency of all students whose home or native language is a language other than English. The district uses the results of this assessment to provide additional language acquisition support for those who qualify. This may include instructional modifications and accommodations to students based on their levels of proficiency in the English language.

These services as well as testing in early spring (called the ACCESS for ELs) is required in compliance with state and federal law.
