Our Program

The Murray Early Childhood Education Center offers preschool classes for children ages three to five years old. Our program offers an environment that provides young children the opportunity to be involved with peers of varying developmental levels. The program is designed to address the needs and interests of each child and to foster the development of abilities, attitudes and skills that will promote educational, physical, and emotional growth for all students. We consider each child to be a unique individual with his/her own rate and style of learning and growth. Our program focuses on active, hands-on experiences that encourage children to explore, make choices and construct knowledge for themselves.

Curriculum

Our staff has trained extensively with the State Office of Education in the High/Scope Curriculum. We focus on active learning, where adults and children share control in the classroom. The curriculum is developmentally appropriate and is responsive to each child's special needs. The curriculum builds on children's experiences and interests. It is challenging without being frustrating; it is consistent, yet flexible. Classroom Environment

The classroom environment is planned and arranged to facilitate child-directed work and play. A variety of learning areas are provided, where students can work individually or in small groups. Materials are easily accessible to the children and activities are open-ended, allowing for success at many different levels of development. Children will have many opportunities each day to problem solve, make choices, test ideas, try new experiences, and practice emerging skills within this safe and nurturing environment.

Our Goals

- To develop a positive self-image and wholesome attitudes.
- To instill a sense of curiosity.
- To develop an awareness of the five senses.
- To provide activities that strengthen and refine gross and fine motor skills.
- To foster self-expression and creativity.
- To teach acceptable outlets for emotions.
- To teach self-control and self-discipline.
- To encourage classroom etiquette.
- To develop positive attitudes toward school and learning.

Preschool Staff
