

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING MINUTES

June 17, 2019

Board Meeting

The Murray City School Board met in a study session on June 17, 2019 at 2:30 p.m. In attendance were Kami Anderson, Jaren Cooper, Glo Merrill, Belinda Johnson, Elizabeth Payne, Jennifer Covington, Superintendent, and Richard Reese, Business Administrator. The meeting was held at the District office, located at 5102 South Commerce Drive, Murray, UT.

Report of the Staff

Board Standards Report – Darren Dean - Director of Personnel, Missy Hamilton - Teaching and Learning Director, Robin Williams – Teaching and Learning Director, and Scott Bushnell, Assistant Superintendent.

The Teaching and Learning Team, Darren Dean, and Superintendent Covington reviewed the 2018-19 school year progress on the Board of Education Standards which include four standards: Standard 1 – Provide learning opportunities for students to excel personally, professionally, and academically; Standard 2 – Foster a culture of mutual respect, leadership development, transparency, and collaboration; Standard 3 – Integrate technology to impact student achievement; Standard 4 – Ensure responsible stewardship over financial resources.

Darren Dean reviewed the progress on Standard 1a – Provide opportunities for students to excel personally and Standard 1b – Provide learning opportunities for students to excel professionally. Scott Bushnell addressed Standard 1c – Provide learning opportunities for students to excel academically.

Superintendent Covington then reviewed progress on Standard 2 – Foster a culture of mutual respect, leadership development, transparency, and collaboration.

Missy Hamilton reviewed Standard 3 – Integrate technology to impact student achievement.


Superintendent Covington reviewed Standard 4 – Ensure responsible stewardship over financial resources. This review included a preliminary discussion on the formation of a school building committee and the orderly replacement of facilities.
