The Murray City School Board met in a regular board meeting on October 10, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. In attendance were Kami Anderson, Belinda Johnson, Jaren Cooper, Glo Merrill, Elizabeth Payne, Jennifer Covington, Superintendent, and Richard Reese, Business Administrator. PTA
