1. Estimated Minimum Quantity 86
 - a. 80 - 2X2 MIMO
 - b. 6 – 4X4 MIMO
2. WiFi 6e minimum
3. 2X Gigabit Ethernet Port minimum
4. On-premise management with three or five year plans are preferred if required to operate the equipment.
5. RF Optimization
6. POe Powered
7. Included brackets for drop ceiling installation.
8. Layer 7 traffic shaping

A funding request will be submitted with E-Rate and all bidders should be E-Rate eligible. The funding for this project may depend on the amount of funding from E-Rate, State of Utah funding, and local funding.
