- **Team Development:** Develop and implement a comprehensive soccer program for high school girls including off-season trainings, practice plans, game strategies and player development.
  - **Coaching & Training:** Provide skill instruction and coaching during practices and games. Focus on improving players' technical skills, tactical knowledge and physical fitness. Foster a positive and supportive team environment.
  - **Game Management:** Organize and lead team practices ensuring players are well-prepared for matches. Develop game strategies and make in-game decisions to maximize team performance.
  - **Player Development:** Identify and nurture the talents of individual players. Provide feedback and guidance to help players improve their skills.
  - **Safety & Compliance:** Ensure play safety by implementing proper training techniques and injury prevention strategies. Be knowledgeable about and adhere to all relevant sports rules and regulations.
  - **Communication:** Maintain effective communication with players, parents, school administration and other stakeholders utilizing the Band App and email. Keep parents informed about team activities, schedules and performance.
  - **Recruitment:** Help recruit and retain talented student-athletes for the soccer program.
  - **Budget Management:** Manage the team's budget which includes fundraising, equipment purchases and end of season banquet expenses.
  - **Leadership:** Serve as a role model for the team demonstrating good sportsmanship and leadership qualities.
  - **Recordkeeping:** Maintain records of player statistics, team performance and other relevant data.
  - **Professional Development:** Stay current with coaching techniques, strategies and best practices by attending coaching clinics and workshops.
  - **Game Day Responsibilities:** Setup for home game (goals, flags, press box). Coordinate game-day logistics, including travel, equipment and team moral. Handle post-game debriefs and analysis with the team.
  - **Community Engagement:** Promote the soccer program within the school and the local soccer community.

Our head coach is responsible for creating a positive and competitive environment where student-athletes can grow both as soccer players and individuals.
