



MCSDB Board Will Share More Facility Recommendation Information and Take Public Comment on Their Proposals to Right-Size Murray for Generations to Come

The Murray City School District Board of Education is proposing a minimal boundary change for the 2024-25 school year, impacting students at Parkside and Liberty Elementary Schools. They are also recommending a bond measure in November to rebuild Riverview Jr. High and add a new wing to Murray High School, paving the way for Riverview and Hillcrest to adopt a middle school curriculum model (grades 6-8). This will also facilitate additional boundary changes, school closures, and construction projects in the future. Murray citizens, parents, students, and educators will have opportunities to learn more about the proposals and express their feedback.

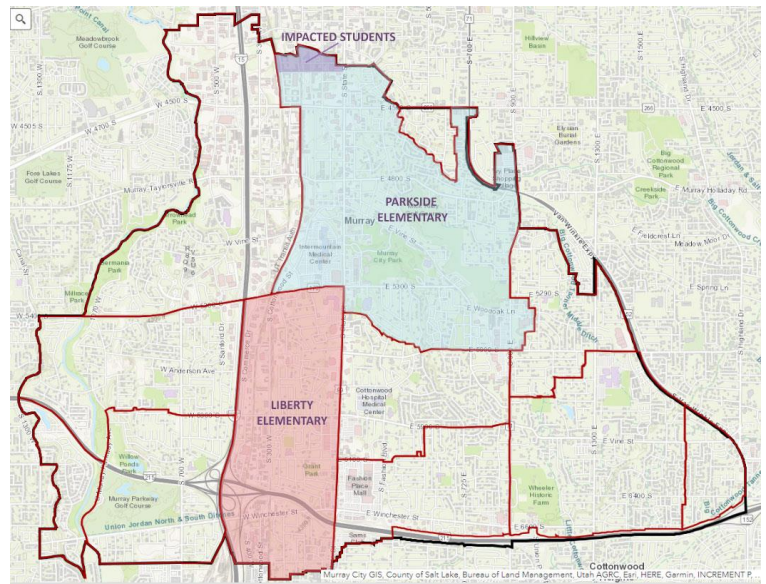
