Welcome to Riverview Junior High School! We are looking forward to the 2024-2025 school year. We ask that you carefully go through all of the information and registration forms on the Murray City School District (MCSD) web site. Please make sure we have accurate registration information - <u>current phone numbers and email addresses are important, they are the main mode of communication we use.</u>

ONLINE REGISTRATION - We encourage you to take advantage of <u>online registration</u> before August 7th. There are TWO steps to registration: 1. Go to the PARENT Aspire account and fill out the student information. Class schedules with locker assignments will be available through your <u>STUDENT</u> Aspire account (NOT the PARENT Aspire account), once the online registration is completed and all required immunizations are verified (if not already on file). Immunization requirement information is on the web site.

2. Go to <u>MYSCHOOLFEES.com</u> and pay your student's fees. If you miss the <u>ONLINE REGISTRATION</u> <u>DEADLINE</u>, registration is required in person on Wednesday, August 7th. You have the choice to pay online or send payment directly to the school at <u>Riverview Junior High School</u>, 751 Tripp Lane, Murray UT 84123.

- Anyone applying for a fee waiver must mail or drop off the fee waiver application along with a copy of the Horizon Card, or COPIES of two current paycheck stubs (dated within the last two months) or a 2023 tax return to verify income (all copies will be shredded after verification).
- Fill out a free and reduced lunch form if appropriate.
- Call the Counseling Office at 801-264-7481 for Aspire access to view student grades and lunch account balances.

Registration for returning students (those who attended a MCSD school last year but did not mail in their registration) is on Wednesday, August 7th, between the hours of 8:00 am - 12:30 pm.

Registration for students who are <u>new</u> to MCSD (those who did not attend a MCSD school last year or those who did not enroll in the spring) is on Thursday, August 8th, **between the hours of 8:00 am - 12:30 pm.**

OPEN HOUSE/BACK TO SCHOOL - Wednesday, August 14th, 5:00 - 6:00 pm.

FIRST DAY/WEEK OF SCHOOL - 7th graders start on Friday, August 16th, 8th and 9th graders start on Monday, August 19th. The first week of school will be half days from August 19th – 23rd. School begins at 7:55 am. and ends at 12:10 pm. Please refer to the dropping off and picking up protocol we ask you to follow. The map will be available on Parent Square and on our school web site. PLEASE DO NOT PULL INTO THE FACULTY PARKING AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON. There will be no school for 7th grade students on Monday, August 19th. All students need to bring their schedule with them to the first day of school - staff will be available to direct students to their classes.

LUNCH - There are two lunch periods that are determined by your student's 5th period teacher. The lunch schedule will be available in all classrooms.
